

Tattoo Aftercare Instructions

[To Pinoy Body Arts Members: The information below was based on various research made by Pinoy Body Arts and amended to conform to environmental conditions of the Philippines (Temperature, Relative Humidity (%RH), etc..) in our efforts to provide useful information on proper Post-Tattoo Aftercare to our members. This information is strictly for guidance purposes only on not in any way binding to members. Application and compliance is absolutely voluntarily. Pinoy Body Arts is not responsible for any in accuracy or damages resulting for the application of the herein provided information.]

Post Tattoo Aftercare Instructions for Clients:

- After 2 hours remove any post tattoo dressing (ex. Plastic wrap, bandage, etc...) from the new tattoo and lather with antibacterial soap, rinse thoroughly with lukewarm water. Soak bandage if stuck before removing. Do not re bandage.
- Let air dry for 15 – 20 minutes or until completely dry.
- Apply a thin coat of A+D ointment twice daily for the first 3 days then switch to “Aquaphor” Healing Ointment made by Eucerin. Repeat this procedure 2 – 3 times daily keeping the area moist for about 3 weeks. Never put too much ointment on your new tattoo. It could block moisture and suck the ink out of your skin causing tattoo to fade after healing.
- Once the tattoo has healed, switch to plain (fragrance free, non-petroleum base or non additives) lotion like Aveeno or Tattoo Goo lotion.
- DO NOT soak or submerge unhealed or new tattoos in water. Short showers are OK. NO baths (sauna) swimming, hot tubs, soaking, and no working out (cardio/weights, etc..) which may cause excessive sweating until the tattoo is healed.
- DO NOT pick or scratch scabs. Let them fall off naturally.
- NO direct Sun for 2 weeks. Once the tattoo has healed, use of high SPF sun block to tattoo when in sun is highly recommended.

Touch-up Disclaimer

If your tattoo is not properly cared for, the life of your tattoo will be shorten or deteriorate. The care of your tattoo may affect whether or not a touch-up is necessary. The artist may charge for touch-ups based on the care of your tattoo which can be determined by the artist after the tattoo has completely healed in about 1 month. To schedule a touch-up, you MUST visit your artist so he may perform proper evaluation on the condition of your tattoo after healing.
